



P3 Seminar: Exploring Public Private Partnerships (P3) in the BC Water Sector

Burnaby, BC November 23, 2011

This seminar will help attendees better understand how P3 projects are planned, structured and managed within the water sector of British Columbia. P3 planning requires a different approach to due diligence on behalf of public agencies, as well as a clear business case that can clearly and specifically identify costs and benefits. Once a business case is in hand, a robust approach to stakeholder communication and consultation is required so that local community Councils and Boards can make educated decisions regarding the water sector infrastructure that will serve their community for decades to come.

Seminar attendees will hear from different P3 experts and stakeholders: this seminar is intended to provide a range of perspectives, not to advocate any point of view. Attendees will:

- Hear different points of view
- Explore P3 case studies
- Meet and discuss local realities with a broad range of P3 experts and practitioners
