

Thursday Keynote Speaker: Dr. Guy Félio, P.Eng., FCSCE, IRP (Climate) Senior Advisor, Asset Management Solutions and Infrastructure Resilience, Stantec Consulting Ltd.

Dr. Félio is a civil engineer with more than 35 years of experience in the field as a university professor, researcher, consultant and policy advisor. At Stantec, Guy provides expertise and support in the areas of asset management and adaptation of the built environment to climate change. During his career at the National Research Council, Guy led the Urban Infrastructure Research group, focusing on technological and management improvements for municipal infrastructure.
