Length of Presentation:

Presentations for **Plenary Sessions** will be 45 minutes in length with approximate 40 minutes allowed for the introduction & presentation and 5 minutes for questions and answers.

Presentations for **Concurrent Sessions** will be 35 minutes in length with approximate 30 minutes allowed for the introduction & presentation and 5 minutes for questions and answers.
