

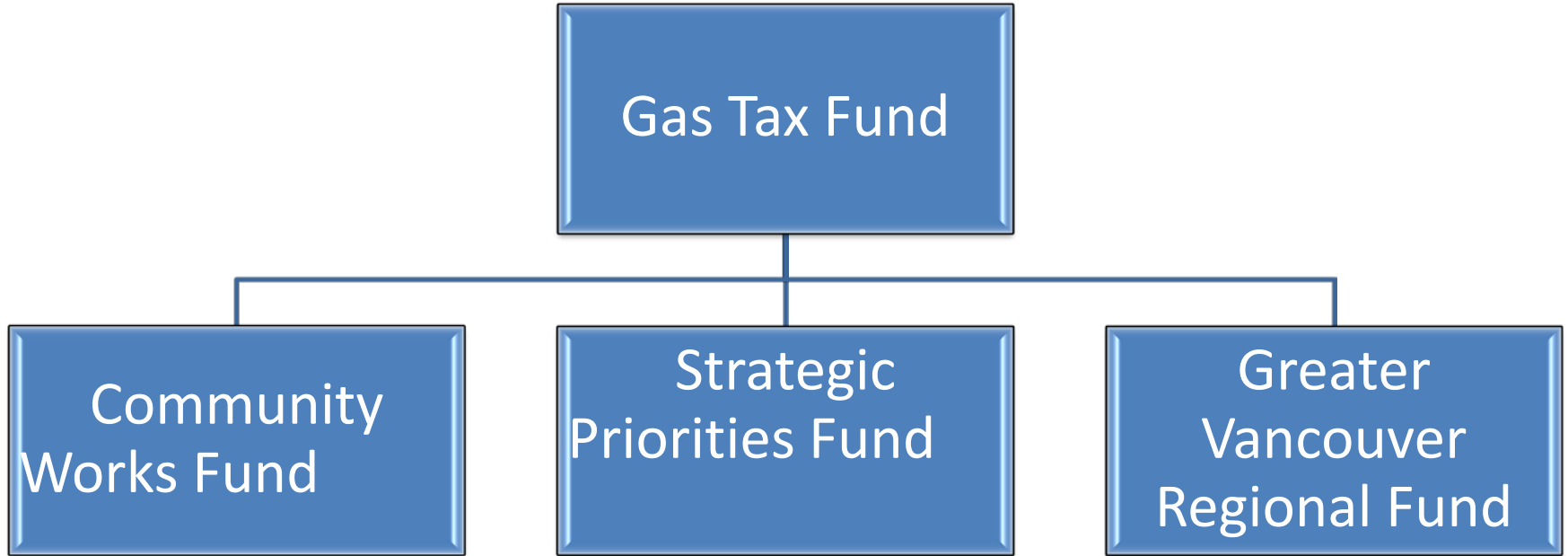

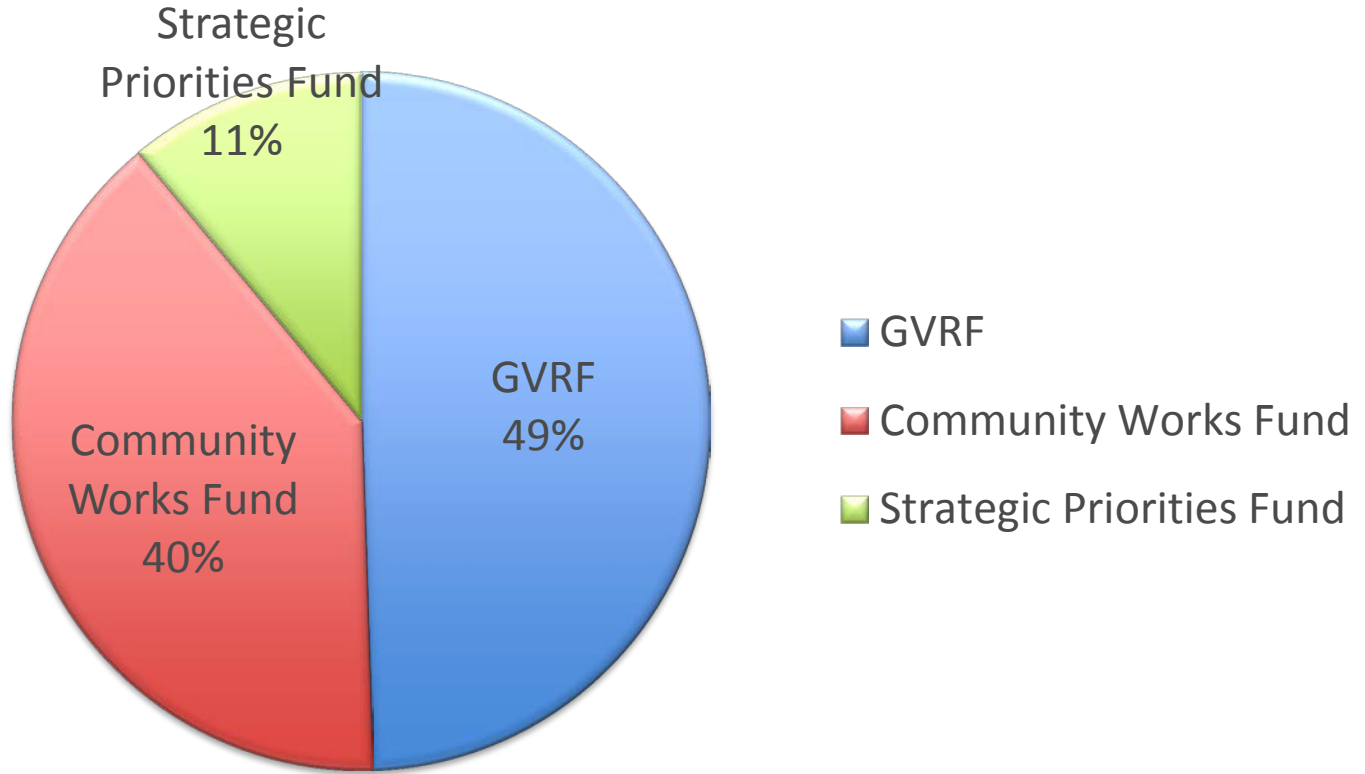

Gas Tax Funding Programs





Funding for BC 2019/20-2023/24

Outcomes Reporting

- Measuring outcomes for completed Gas Tax projects since 2014
- Includes baseline data of local government Asset Management current practices
- Report submitted to Canada on March 31, 2018 and available on UBCM website

Local Government Program Services

- Age-friendly Communities
- Asset Management Planning & Training Subsidies
- Community Child Care Planning & Space Creation
- Community Emergency Preparedness Fund
- Community Resiliency Investment Program
- Regional Community to Community Forum

Age-friendly Communities

- Initiated in 2005
- Funded by the Ministry of Health
- Supports planning or projects that make communities more age-friendly
- 100% grants of \$25,000/\$15,000
- Application deadline: Nov. 2, 2018

Asset Management Planning

- Funded by Ministry of Municipal Affairs & Housing and UBCM
- Supports local governments to improve AM policy and practice
- 50% matching grants up to \$15,000; can be leveraged with MAMP
- Next deadline: September 28, 2018

Asset Management Training Subsidies

- Funded by Ministry of Municipal Affairs & Housing and UBCM
- Provides 50% of registration fee for up to 3 local government staff for eligible AMBC events
- Deadline: within 30 days of attending

Community Child Care - Planning

- Funded by Ministry of Children & Family Development
- Support LGs to engage in child care planning, develop inventory and action plan
- Grants of up to \$25,000, 100% funding
- Application deadline: January 18, 2019

Community Child Care – Space Creation

- Funded by Ministry of Children & Family Development
- Create new licensed child care spaces in LG facilities for children 0 - 5
- Grants of up to \$1 m, 100% funding
- Application deadline: January 18, 2019

Community Emergency Preparedness Fund

- Funded by Ministry of Transportation & Infrastructure
- Intended to enhance resiliency of communities in responding to emergencies
- Five funding streams

CEPF: Emergency Social Services

- Build local capacity for emergency social services through training, volunteer recruitment/retention and equipment
- Grants of up to \$25,000, 100% funding
- First deadline: approved 84 projects - \$1.9 m
- Application deadline: October 5, 2018

CEPF: Emergency Operations Centres & Training

- Purchase of equipment/supplies to maintain or improve EOCs and enhance capacity through training and exercises
- Grants of up to \$25,000, 100% funding
- First intake: 100 approved projects, \$2.3 m
- Application deadline: Feb. 1, 2019

CEPF: Flood Planning

- Grants for Flood Risk Assessments, Flood Mapping and Flood Mitigation Planning
- Grants of up to \$150,000, 100% funding
- First intake: approved 20 projects totaling \$2.5 m
- Application deadline: February 22, 2019

CEPF: Structural Flood Mitigation

- Prevent, eliminate or reduce the impacts of hazards through construction of structural flood mitigation projects
- Grants of up to \$750,000, 100% funding
- First intake: approved 17 projects totalling 9.5 m
- Application deadline: October 25, 2019

CEPF: Evacuation Route Planning

- Development of evacuation route plans
- One funding intake
- Application deadline: Nov. 30, 2018

Community Resiliency Investment Program

- Funded by Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations & Rural Development
- FireSmart Community Funding & Supports – which replaces SWPI
- Scaled grants: \$25,000 to \$100,000, 100% funding
- Application deadline: December 7, 2018



Regional Community to Community Forums

- Jointly funded by federal, provincial, UBCM
- Increased understanding and improved relationships between First Nations and local governments
- 50% matching grants of up to \$5,000
- Deadline: October 19, 2018
